ORDER:-

Every year the Government of India release Special Central Assistance towards the implementation of Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) in the State. The assistance received is utilised for the implementation of Economic Development Scheme for the Scheduled Castes through the Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation Limited (TAHDCO) and infrastructure development in the areas dominated by the Scheduled Castes.

2) The Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment in its letter 2nd read above, have released a sum of Rs.25,80,64,000/- (Rupees Twenty five crore eighty lakh and sixty four thousand only) as First Instalment of Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Caste Sub Plan for the year 2016-2017.

3) The Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment in its letter 3rd read above, have released of an amount of Rs.19,55,67,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Crore Fifty Five lakh and Sixty Seven thousand only) to Tamil Nadu as 2nd Instalment of Special Central Assistance (SCA) to Scheduled Castes Sub-Plan (SCSP) during the year 2016-2017.

4) The Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment in its letter 5th read above have released a sum of Rs.34,47,42,000/- (Rupees Thirty four crore forty seven lakhs and forty two thousand only) as balance amount of 2nd Installment of grant in aid under the Scheme of Special Central Assistance to Scheduled Caste Sub Plan for the year 2016-2017 including the arrears for 2015-2016 to Tamil Nadu.

5) The Government of India has requested to make necessary arrangement to credit this amount to State Government in accordance with the procedure already available with the State Government. The SCA being additive to the Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCSP) of the States/UTs should be used only for specific sector wise schemes covering Scheduled Caste population as per latest guidelines on the subject.

6) The Government of India has also requested the State Government to furnish quarterly progress reports in respect of utilization of SCA to SCSP to the Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment within 15 days after the end of each quarter in the prescribed proforma already available with the State Government.

7) As per instructions contained in Ministry of Finance, Department of Economics Affairs circular No.F2(23)-13(CDN)/95, dated 10.02.1995 any unspent balance amount of previous years cannot be carried forward for expenditure during the next financial year but will be adjusted against the amount of SCA due to State Government/UTs Administration for the current year, at the time of release of Final instalment for the current year. The States/UTs' have to ensure the full utilization of funds for the purpose for which it is given to them.

8) In the Government Order first read above, it was ordered that 10 % of the Special Central Assistance received from Government of India towards SCSP shall be utilised for providing infrastructure facilities to Scheduled Castes habitations and Adi Dravidar Welfare Schools / Hostels and the balance 90 % shall be released to the Personal Deposit Account of the Managing Director, TAHDCO thro' Director, Adi Dravidar Welfare for implementing various Economic Development Scheme for Scheduled Castes.

9) The Government order fourth read above, order was issued on the action plan and guidelines for implementing Economic Development Schemes for Scheduled Castes during 2016-2017 through the TAHDCO.

10) The Government after careful consideration accord sanction to release a sum of Rs.31,02,67,800/- (Rupees Thirty one crore Two lakhs sixty seven thousand eight hundred only) being the 90% of the total amount of Rs.34,47,42,000/- (Rupees Thirty four crore forty seven lakhs forty two thousand only) received from the Government of India as the balance of second instalment of SCA to SCSP for the year 2016-2017 including the Arrears for 2015-2016 to the TAHDCO for implementation of the Economic Development Schemes for Scheduled Castes by the Managing Director, TAHDCO for the year 2016-2017.

11) The expenditure sanctioned in para 10 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

“2225–Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes–01-Welfare of Scheduled Castes–793 Special Central Assistance for Scheduled Caste Component Plan–Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-III-Centrally Sponsored – SB Implementation of Economic Development Programmes under Scheduled Castes Sub Plan (SCSP) 09 Grants-in-Aid-09- Others (D.P.C. 2225 01 793 SB 0998)”

12. The expenditure sanctioned in para 10 above shall be met from the provision allotted in RE 2016-2017.

13. The amount sanctioned in para 10 above shall not be paid in cash but shall be credited to the following head of account by means of an account payee cheque in favour of the Personal Deposits Account of TAHDCO Limited :-

“K Deposits and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing interest-8443-00- Civil Deposits–800 – other Deposits-BY-Deposits of Tamilnadu Adi-Dravidar Housing Development Corporation (TAHDCO), (DPC 8443 00 800 BY 0004) (‘out go’) (DPC 8443 00 800 BY 000G) (Receipt)”

14. The Director of Adi Dravidar Welfare, Chennai -5 is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 10 above by an Account Payee Cheque in favour of “Personal Deposit Account” of the Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation Limited (TAHDCO) Chennai with Account Number. Government of India released Rs.3636.98 lakhs against notional allocation of Rs.6649.57 lakhs for the year 2015-2016. Hence the balance of arrear for the year 2015-2016 is 3012.59 lakhs. Further Government of India released 4536.31 lakhs as First and Second Installment of 2016-2017 against notional allocation 4536.31. The Government of India further released Rs.3447.42 lakhs as balance for 2nd instalment including arrears for 2015-2016.

15) The Managing Director, TAHDCO is directed to adjust the unspent balance of grant released in earlier year if any, for the current schemes. The Director of Adi Dravidar Welfare and the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation Limited (TAHDCO) shall ensure that the funds are utilized for the real purpose and to the actual beneficiaries fully without any shortfall or complaints.

16) The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation Limited (TAHDCO) and the Director of Adi Dravidar Welfare are directed to maintain separate accounts for Special Central Assistance funds operated and disbursed by them for the various components separately for every financial year for implementing various Welfare Schemes. The relevant registers for the various disbursements of assistance should be maintained with the complete details of beneficiaries.

17) If any failure is noticed in this regard severe action will be taken against the Officers, who are responsible for such lapses. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Housing and Development Corporation Limited (TAHDCO) and the Director of Dravidar Welfare are directed to send the details of expenditure under the Special Central Assistance schemes for each and every month on or before 10th of the succeeding month to the Government.

18) This order issues with concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 9507/AD&TW/2017, dated.03.03.2017.
